
Current Construction Impacts

McKnight will be open to through traffic beginning August 31st. Due to rain impacts, paving on McKnight between Larpenteur and Arlington will continue on September 3rd under traffic. Commuters who take this route can expect slower traffic and potential lane restrictions during this paving period. While access will be available, commuters are encouraged to utilize the regional detour in place during the paving operations.

We know road closures can be inconvenient, and we appreciate your patience. The detour route for the Ivy Ave E is still active. The Ivy detour is anticipated to remain in place until early Fall 2024.

Please follow the posted *Ivy detour route* and *McKnight detour route* on the project website.

Please note, resident access will be provided at all times to the locations shown as "Closed to Thru Traffic". Please follow posted detour signs.



Work Completed Week of August 26

- Sanitary Sewer and Watermain work continued on Arlington Ave within the project site
- Roadway work continued on McKnight Rd N
- Crews continued mass grading between and throughout the project site
- Structural crews continued retaining wall construction within the project site

Anticipated Work for Week of September 2

- No work will take place on Monday, September 2 due to the Labor Day Holiday
- Final paving will be completed on McKnight Rd N on Tuesday
- Storm Sewer and Watermain work will continue on Arlington Ave within the project site
- Crew will continue mass grading between and throughout the project site
- Structural crews will continue retaining wall construction within the project site
