Project Update - October 4, 2024

Current Construction Impacts

The Contractor will begin the **N Winthrop reconstruction Monday, October 7**, weather dependent. Winthrop reconstruction includes sanitary sewer improvements, new watermain, storm sewer, and roadway. N Winthrop St will be closed to thru traffic from Sherwood Ave to Nebraska Ave E with limited access to driveways during working hours (7 a.m. to 7 p.m.). Resident access will be provided at all times to the locations shown as "Closed to Thru Traffic".

The active Winthrop construction area is shown in the map below.

Simultaneously, Zayo will be completing private utility relocation work from Larpenteur Ave E to Cottage Ave E. There will be no road closures related to this work but increased construction work and minor traffic impacts may occur.

Final paving for Ivy Ave E is anticipated for mid-October, weather pending. We know road closures can be inconvenient, and we appreciate your continued patience throughout this improvement process. The detour route for the Ivy Ave E is still active. Please follow the posted *Ivy detour route* on the project website.

Please note, resident access will be provided at all times to the locations shown as "Closed to Thru Traffic". Please follow posted detour signs.
