Current Construction Impacts

The N Winthrop St closure is still under effect. N Winthrop St will be closed to thru traffic from Sherwood Ave to Nebraska Ave E with limited access to driveways during working hours (7 a.m. to 7 p.m.). Resident access will be provided at all times to the locations shown as "Closed to Thru Traffic".

The final paving work on Ivy Avenue is now underway! The top layer of pavement is scheduled for completion next week. Please use caution while driving on Ivy Ave until paving is fully finished. We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout this project.

Public Infrastructure Work Completed Week of November 11

- Final paving of Ivy Ave, Arlington Ave between Howard and McKnight was completed.
- Sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and watermain installation continued on N Winthrop St.
- Crews continued mass grading between and throughout the project site.
- Storm sewer and sanitary sewer crews continued installation on Howard St within the project site.
- Concrete curb and gutter was poured along Winthrop between Arlington and Sherwood.

Anticipated Public Infrastructure Work for Week of November 18

- Sanitary sewer, storm sewer, and watermain installation will be completed on N Winthrop St.
- Storm sewer and sanitary sewer crews will complete installation on Howard St within the project site.
- Final paving on Ivy Ave and Winthrop St between Sherwood and Arlington, weather pending. Access to Ivy may be impacted during normal work hours while final paving operations are completed.
