Current Construction Impacts

The N Winthrop St closure is still under effect. N Winthrop St will be closed to thru traffic from Sherwood Ave to Nebraska Ave E with limited access to driveways during working hours (7 a.m. to 7 p.m.). Resident access will be provided at all times to the locations shown as "Closed to Thru Traffic".

Due to the forcasted rain this week, final paving for Ivy Ave E is anticipated for the week of November 4, weather pending. We know road closures can be inconvenient, and we appreciate your continued patience throughout this improvement process. The detour route for the Ivy Ave E is still active. Please follow the posted *Ivy detour route* on the project website.

Public Infrastructure Work Completed Week of October 21
